# ANIMAL CPR STEPS

LAY ANIMAL ON FIRM SURFACE, ON ITS SIDE WITH BACK AGAINST PERSON

## STEP 1: CHECK FOR BREATH/PULSE

- 1) OPEN AIRWAY - CHECK FOR BLOCKAGE
- 2) CHECK BREATH - HAND ON CHEST
- 3) CHECK PULSE - TWO FINGERS ON CHEST BY LEFT ELBOW OR ON INNER THIGH

## STEP 2: NO BREATH/PULSE → GIVE BREATH

- 1) EXTEND HEAD BACK + CLOSE MOUTH
  - 2) BREATH INTO ANIMAL'S NOSE
- \* ONE BREATH EVERY 3 SECONDS\*

## STEP 3: NO HEARTBEAT → START CHEST COMPRESSIONS

- 1) FIND HEART - PLACE ANIMAL'S FRONT ELBOW AGAINST HIS BODY TO MARK HEART
  - 2) PLACE PALM ON HEART, LACE FINGERS, LOCK ELBOWS
- \*3 QUICK AND FIRM COMPRESSIONS FOR EACH BREATH\*

CONTINUE CPR UNTIL ANIMAL IS IN CARE OF VET
